



How many boats are in the painting? Can you guess what colours were used?


GUESS WHAT I AM!

Fun Fact: An easy way to tell if I am acid free/archival is a burn test. Take a small scrap of me and set it alight in a safe place such as the kitchen sink. (Make sure you have an adult with you if you are under 18 years). If the ash is black, it has lignin in it so it's not archival. If it's white, it's lignin free and archival.







SEA AQUARELLE, Odesa – 2020.

Dates: November 6. **Place**: Odesa in Ukraine.

Application Deadline: April 15.

Fees: Payment for the participation and submission of the original watercolor works is done individually or through IWS country leader of the participating country. You have to pay for participation in case of announcement of the participants list!

Participation in exhibition format + catalog:

For IWS members or when applying through your IWS country's leader – 45, individually – 50 euros.

The cost of participation in the format "Exhibition + Catalog" includes:

- participation in the exhibition,
- framed works,
- catalog,
- certificate,
- participation in all demonstrations of mastery of international watercolor masters,
- participation in the prize draw from our ART partners.

In the "Catalog" format:

For IWS members, when applying through your country's IWS leader

- -35 euros, an individual 40 euros.
- catalog,
- certificate,
- participation in the prize draw from our ART partners.
- The organizers of the exhibition are not responsible for any damages of the work during delivery to the organizing country. We suggest you insure your job.

Returns of works and catalogs are subject to an additional cost:

Individual shipping – of EUR 25.

Group shipping (from 3 participants) – EUR 10 per person.

Conditions:

- Artists from the age of 18 can take part in the exhibition.
- The topic of participation is not restricted.
- Only original works made personally by the author during the last three years are allowed.
- The exhibition includes works of formats 30×40 cm, 40×60 cm, 50×70 cm vertical or horizontal orientation.
- Each participant can submit one work.
- Photos of submitted works must correspond to the actually delivered works.
- A *.jpg (JPG) digital image of at least 3 MB, but not more than 6 MB, with a resolution of at least 300 DPI.
- Fill out the application and send it to your country's IWS supervisor by April 15, 2020 or individually at iwslvua@gmail.com.

MINI CASTRA 2020 (small format) Slovenia

Dates of event: August 29 - October 3rd.

Place: Ajdovščina, Slovenia

Dates and Application Deadline:

- January 28: invitation to the participation on Mini Castra 2020.
- May 3: Deadline for sending the digital photo of your watercolours.
- May 17: Announcement of the selected artworks.
- June 6: Deadline for sending the original watercolours from your country (at the post office, DHL, etc.)
- July 20: Deadline for paying the participation fee.
- August 29 & 30: International watercolour extempore in Vipavski Križ.
- August 29: Mini Castra 2020 opening ceremony and award issuing.
- October 3: End of the exhibition.
- October 31: Deadline for sending back the original watercolours (this applies for the organisers).

Fees: IWS Members 50 USD.

Conditions:

- Watercolor Maximum 2 years old (from2018);
- Format: maximum 21 x 29.7 cm (8.3 x 11.7 in), minimum 14,8 x 21,0 cm (5.8 x 8.3 in).

- One watercolour artist can participate with a maximum of 4 artworks. Instructions For Participation:
- The watercolour artist can apply by sending photos of a maximum 4 artworks to iws.slovenia@gmail.com
- The professional art committee will inform the selected authors on May 17th.
- All selected artists will receive an email with detailed instructions about how to send the original watercolour and pay the participation fee.

Instructions For Sending Digital Photos Of Your Watercolours:

- Format: .jpg /.jpeg.
- Size: between 2M pixels and 3M pixels.
- Resolution: 300 dpi.
- Title: Name and Surname Country Title Year Size.
- Deadline: May 3rd.
- Your digital photo will appear in the catalogue so please, send us the best quality photo!

International Watercolor Contest PREMIO TLALOC 2020

IWS MEXICO

ELIGIBILITY

- The event is open to artists from Mexico and abroad 18 years old and above.
- Artists can participate in two categories:

Your city (paint your city and every single corner of it)

Characters from your city (typical, famous or daily life people of your city)

- Each artist can send one work per category.
- Medium: 100% watercolor on paper.
- Size: 56 x 38 cm (half sheet) horizontal or vertical.
- Original works only made in 2018-2020 not previously exhibited.

- No collage, pastels, digital images or any form of print or reproductions will be accepted. No class work, copies or likenesses of another artist's work including published source or reference not attributable to the artist.
- Each participant is obligated to show his work for the entire length of the exposition.

There is no participation fee.

• Entries should be registered before May 29, 2020 in the following link:

- Image should be already cropped, the size of image should be between 3MB 5MB, with a resolution of 300 dpi and with no less than 1500 pixels in the longer dimension. The file must be named according to the following format: Country_Author_Title_Size_Year of painting.jpg
- Modifications or digital Improvement of the painting is not allowed.
- Results will be announced on June 18, 2020 in the Website http://iwsmexico.com

Shipment and return of paintings are at the expense of the participants.

• 100-120 paintings to integrate the exhibition. Each selected artist will receive directions for the shipment and return of the original work.

AWARDS

- First Place: \$70,000.00 MXN (Mexican Pesos) cash prize in each category.
- Second Place: \$50,000.00 MXN (Mexican Pesos) cash prize in each category.
- Third Place: \$30,000.00 MXN (Mexican Pesos) cash prize in each category.
- Excellence Awards by category will be given to those with outstanding works. And all contestants will receive Certificates of Participation.
- The exhibition will take place from November 07, 2020 to January 5, 2021.
