



From July 8 to August 30, Sonia Mocnik & Joyce Goodwin have a beautiful show in the Gallery at Hycroft of which they are members.





Theme: Eggstreme Textures!

Due to the COVID Pandemic the physical workshop that was due to have taken place in Cambridge, Ontario is going virtual, so is now open to artists anywhere!

This workshop will be a fun, imaginative and typically Ona style event where you get to explore ways to create a whole host of textures in transparent watercolour and have a lot of fun along the way.

Ona will set up and invite participating artists to a series of Zoom conference video calls. You will meet via zoom 3-4 times over the course of 1 week which will give you plenty of time in between these times to work on your own painting

A full materials list will be provided when you sign up but basically all you need is a computer with some camera function so Ona can see you (most laptops have an inbuilt camera), and a ton of enthusiasm.




